

Orientation Information

Arrival at Queens College

On their first day at Queens College, all students are required to attend an orientation session. Orientation sessions run every Friday before the course start date.

Students must report to Queens College at 9.30am, with their passport and details of their current Australian address – even if it is only temporary. Students will be required to complete forms for our administration records and must ensure they have all the necessary information.

Orientation session:

- 9:30 am. - 11.00 am.
- Followed by a **Placement Test** and this should conclude by 11.00 am.

Class timetable:

- **English Courses** – Monday to Thursday from 8.30 am. – 2.30 pm.
- **Business Courses** – Monday and Tuesday from 8.30 am. – 5.00 pm.
- **Diploma Courses** – Wednesday and Thursday from 8.30 am. – 5.00 pm.

What to bring and prepare for Orientation day:

- Passport
- Residential address in Australia (even if temporary)
- OSHC proof (if student did not arrange health cover with us)

During orientation students will receive the following information:

- Timetable
- Student Handbook
- Orientation Guide
- Information about College rules, policies and procedures, safety guidelines
- Tour around our campus
- Student ID cards arrangement
- Concession card Application Form for public transportation in Brisbane (buses, trains and ferries)

Students will also be assigned to classes during the orientation, so it is very important that all new students attend orientation. Students must bring writing materials and electronic devices (iPads, tablets etc) to use in class.
